Why not join the program to collaborate with overseas students online?

As a school selected for the FY 2018 Inter-University Exchange Project of the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology, Japan, Osaka City University (OCU) is implementing a Program to Develop Collaborative Social Innovators that uses Collaborative Online International Learning (COIL). Since 2020, OCU has conducted entirely online programs entitled Socially Innovative Global Classroom: Online (SIGLOC-online) to provide international education unaffected by COVID-19.



Characteristics of SIGLOC-online 2021

- ICT tools for SIGLOC-online: Zoom, Slack, Canvas and Google drive
- The program contents are the same. (The 9th SIGLOC is intensive.)
- 100% online (all students/instructors will participate from their own places during the entire period.)
- Multi-national, collaborative learning (students from two countries or more per group)
- Teamwork within small groups
- Conferral of a Certificate of Completion
