

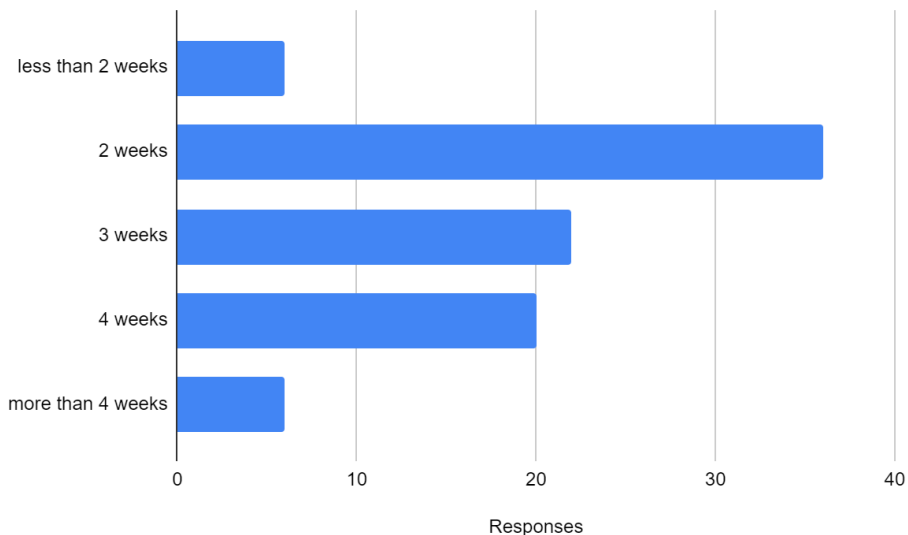

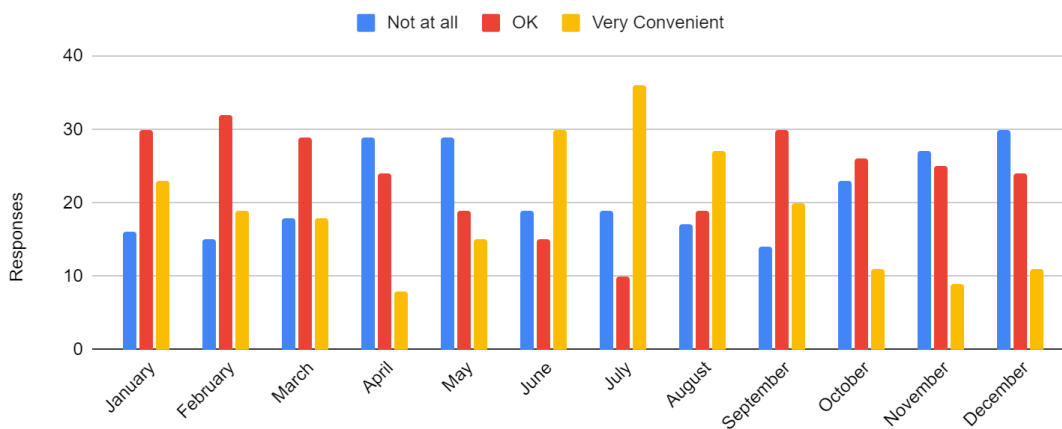

5. Choose the most appropriate one for the program length (including weekend activities).

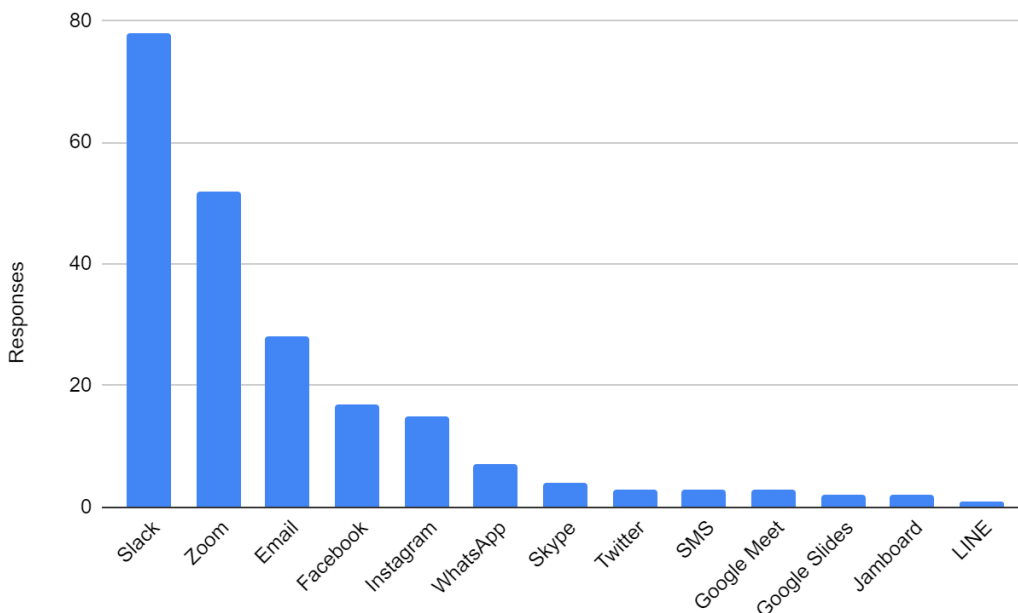


6. Choose the convenient month(s) for the students in your school to participate in this kind of program. Please check the appropriate answer for each month.


