The following are some of these activities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Adopt-a-Seedling Supporters can adopt a seedling of any of the Philippine native tree species like narra, dao, kamagong, makaasim, and lauan and Haribon will take care of your adopted tree for 3 years. - Nurture-a-Tree With a Nurture Card, a seedling that has been previously planted under the Adopt-a-Seedling Program will be nurtured in a person's name. - Join a tree planting! Tree planting activities take place between July and November every year during the rainy season to improve survival rates of newly-planted seedlings. |
